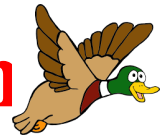

This week the children will be bringing home their first "Oxford Tree Reading book" from our reading scheme. The first sets of books do not have words in, so we would encourage you to look at the pictures with your child, talk about the story and say the names of the characters. As the children become more confident at recognising sounds, blending them to read words and recognising words on sight, they will be introduced to books with words.
