The Ducks will also be drawing pictures of their houses so if you could send a photograph in of your house to help them with this activity that would be great too! Thank you

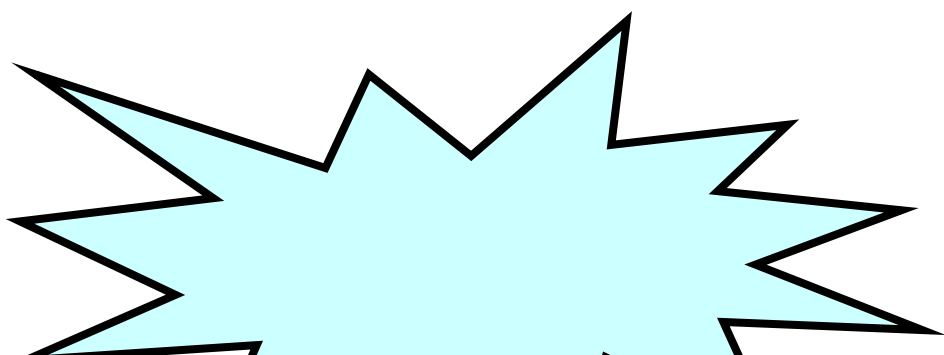
