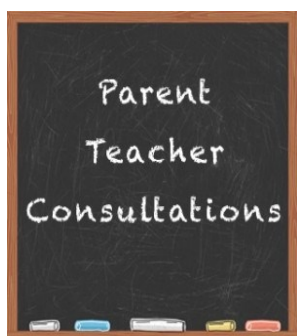

Hello Everyone,

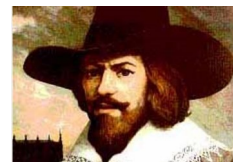
Next week is the last one for this half term. The children have worked really hard and are already beginning to make progress. We will give you detailed information at the parent consultations on Monday 17th October.

Sponsored Bounce

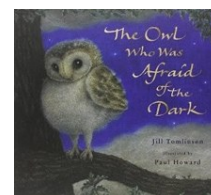


We are planning to hold a sponsored bounce on Friday 21st October to raise funds for school activities.
