

Pupil Premium statement 2013 - 2014

Pupil premium is allocated to children from low-income families who are eligible for free School Meals and children who have been looked after continuously for more than 6 months. This amount is £900 per child. There is also an amount of £250 for children whose parents are serving in the armed forces.

Grant Allocation 2014-2015

The funding received from Pupil Premium in 2014-15 will be allocated in the following ways;

- teaching assistant support throughout the school to focus interventions in phonics, reading and maths £48,333
- Additional SEN TA support for short term specific interventions for individual children or groups £14,385
- Providing materials and equipment to enhance learning/support after school clubs/ provide weekly stickers and awards for excellent attendance £15,000
- Engaging the services of EWO to impact on attendance £500
- Additional equipment and resources to support Breakfast club £15,000
- Additional staffing and resources to support lunchtime provision with every child in school receiving a free hot school meal £10,000
