Grant Allocation 2014-2015

The funding received from Pupil Premium in 2015-16 will be allocated in the following ways;

- Full time SENCo and Intervention Co-ordinator £25,000
- Additional full time teacher in reception to keep classes small to give best possible start to school £25,000
- Four additional full time TAs to provide short term specific interventions for individual children or groups £80,000
- Providing materials and equipment to enhance learning/support after school clubs/ provide weekly stickers and awards for excellent attendance £15,000
- Engaging the services of EWO to impact on attendance £1,500
- Additional equipment and resources and staff to support Breakfast club £10,200
- Additional staffing and resources to support lunchtime provision with every child in school receiving a free hot school meal £10,000
