



## Year 1 Autumn 2 Fire and Ice.



### Overview

This term will begin with our focus on 'The Great Fire of London' and end with learning about The Arctic.

### Science

Through our work on The Arctic children will learn about the animals that live there. They will learn the vocabulary of herbivores, carnivores and omnivores.

### Geography

Children will learn to use simple maps and globes. They will learn to identify the UK and The Arctic on the world map and will learn about how the two localities are different.

### History

Through the fire part of the topic children will learn about the main events of The Great Fire of London. They will learn how the fire started, how it spread so quickly and how it was eventually stopped.

**ICT:** Children will be using basic word processing skills.

Cross-curricular links using Maths, Science and Phonics games.

**Maths:** ongoing daily maths lessons will continue to focus on numbers, counting, place value, shape and calculation.

### Cross curricular maths

- Sorting animals into carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.

**Literacy:** ongoing daily guided reading session, daily phonics session, grammar and composition taught through daily literacy hour. Handwriting taught discretely.

### Cross curricular Literacy

- Non-fiction writing based around The Arctic.
- Non-fiction writing about Arctic animals.

**Creative:** Ongoing weekly music lesson based on Music Express.

**PE:** Weekly games lessons with a PE coach. Wake up shake up dance activities.
